



Patrol Rifle Training

POLICE PATROL RIFLE / CARBINE COURSE (3-Days/24 Hours) This comprehensive three day Police Patrol Rifle Operators Course is designed to familiarize the first responder with the police use of the patrol rifle and develop his/her proficiency with the rifle platform.

The rifle course will focus on the needs of the police first responder deploying in an urban environment; tactically preparing the student to face the threats presented from armed suspects, armed criminal gangs, active shooter calls, and terrorist siege circumstances. Students will learn and develop the skills needed to confidently use and deploy the patrol rifle in their first responder capacity. Students will train from zero to 300 feet.

During the course, students will learn basic handling and marksmanship skills, as well as, perform advanced shooting drills. Students will qualify on approved O.P.O.T.C. Tactical Rifle Qualification Course (#25-CPD-91-TWS/A-01), Patrol Rifle Protective Gas Mask Course, Decision Fire Course, and will complete a timed and scored team movement and use of cover course of fire.

Students should be in good physical condition to attend. For certification, students must complete all qualifications, a written test, and must show the aptitude to safely handle and tactically deploy a rifle in close quarters to receive certification.
